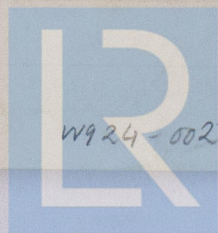
No ceiling has been fitted on the tank top under the hatchways of this vessel, and the Builders were therefore requested to obtain the Owners' consent to this omission, and the vessel was classed on the 8th June, subject to this being done.

The Builders have now forwarded a letter from the Owners consenting to the omission of the ceiling.

It is submitted the vessel might now be allowed to remain classed without special conditions.
