Ceiling is fitted over the limbers only, and the Builders state it is not their intention to fit any on the inner bottom, the thickness of the tank tops is as given on the approved midship section, which is enclosed, together with the approved profile, and deck plan.

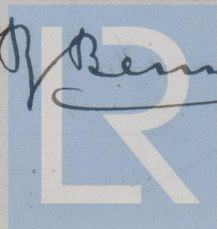
As the vessel is rapidly approaching completion, I shall be glad to have a reply by wire.
