MIELERO.—*New York*, Jan. 30.—A wireless message states that the tank steamer Mielero, from Matanzas, laden with molasses in bulk, broke in two and sank at sea. One boat with the chief officer and 17 men rescued, but another boat containing master and 22 men is still missing.—*Reuter*.

—*Washington*, Jan. 31.—A wireless message announces that the steamer Sucrosa has saved the crew of the tank steamer Mielero, which was reported yesterday to have broken in two and to have sunk at sea.—*Reuter*.
