I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, and, in reply, I have to inform you that my steamer "DENISE" left Rouen on the 18th of January for Cardiff where all the repairs will be carried out to put her again in good condition.

With a view to this we have engaged at Cardiff a dry dock for the 21st of January and we ask you to complete at the same time the Special Survey No. 1. which we were obliged to leave unfinished on account of the regulations of the Board of Trade.
