This vessel is reported to have

stranded on Great Natuna Island, Malay Archipelago,  
on the 15th December, 1939.

She is in an exposed position,  
Nos. 1, 2 and 4 holds are leaky and it is  
expected that the bottom in the double bottom  
tanks are holed fore and aft. Salvage is considered  
impossible before the end of the monsoon in March  
or April, and it is stated that the steamer is  
fully expected to become a total loss.

In reply to the special casualty  
notice, the London Representatives state that the  
Underwriters have not accepted the Notice of  
Abandonment as there may be a chance of salving  
and repairing the steamer when the monsoon season  
is ended.

29th April, 1940.

In reply to inquiry the London  
Representatives state that they understand a  
survey party has been sent from Singapore to  
ascertain whether this steamer can be salved, and  
they are awaiting the result of the survey.

They add they will advise this  
Office as soon as they receive any information.

20th August, 1940.

Lloyd's List, 3.8.40. state the vessel is cradled  
on rock and coral, holed in several places and  
that salvage is impracticable. The London  
Agents concur.
