The Owners propose to supply to this vessel anchors of  
the stockless type and the Amsterdam Surveyor requests  
the weights of same to be marked on the plans.

Previous similar cases in which stockless anchors  
have been supplied to sailing vessels have been approved  
with the weights of the anchors 10% heavier than the weights  
of the ordinary anchors including the stock.

It is submitted the proposal might be approved provided  
the weights are increased 10%, as in the previous similar cases  
for the same builders, in which case the weights of the 2  
bower anchors will be <sup>each 9.3.24</sup> 9.3.24 each.
