The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to permanent repairs being effected to collision damage to stem, stem plating etc. at the Owners' convenience.

The 2nd S.S. No. 2 became due 4.40, and it was proposed to make a General Examination with a view to its postponement on the vessel's return.

Repaired shell plate No. 8 in 3rd strake below sheer (s.s.) requires to be further examined at the next dry docking.

The HULL Surveyors now report the vessel Generally Examined afloat, No. 8 shell plate, as above, examined and found efficient.

The Owners request that this be accepted as a permanent repair, and in the Surveyors' opinion this merits favourable consideration.

The fore peak tank will require to be largely renewed when permanent repairs are carried out, but in the meantime is efficient.

An additional doubling plate has been fitted to No. 1 plate in 3rd strake below sheer (p & s).

The condition of the vessel generally in other respects is stated to be good.

In reply to enquiry the Surveyors intimate that the postponement desired is until the expiration of the year of grace, and they recommend that this be granted.

It is submitted action be deferred accordingly.

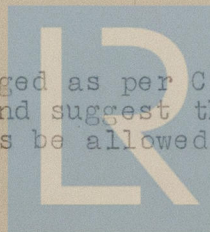
Delete No. 8 shell plate.
