S Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your report No.50909 on the steamer "TYMERIC", and it is noted therefrom that a General Examination has been held with a view to the postponement of the Second Special Survey No.2, which became due in April last, but before submitting the case to the Committee, I may say it is concluded the postponement desired and recommended by you, is until some time before the expiration of the Year of Grace in April next.

In this connection, I think it well to point out that Circulars Nos.1764, and 1765 are only intended to apply to cases in which the Year of Grace has expired or an "Examined" record is desired to carry the vessel on until some time beyond the expiration of the Year of Grace.

It is observed that a fee of £10. 0. 0. for the General Examination has been applied for but the present practice in dealing with postponements within the Year of Grace is to apply circular 1702 and to charge a fee in accordance with the usual practice for General Examinations in that category.

I shall, therefore, be glad to learn the period for which you recommend that the Special Survey may be postponed and should this be within the Year of Grace, perhaps you will render the amended account for your examination and let me know the action taken.
