It is submitted before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the Surveyors be informed it is noted that a General Examination has been held with a view to postponement of the S.S. 2nd No. 2, due 4.40, and that it is concluded the postponement desired and recommended is until some time before the expiration of the year of grace.

It might be pointed out to the Surveyors that Circulars No. 1764 and 1765 are only intended to apply to cases in which the year of grace has expired.

It is observed that a fee of £10 for the General Examination has been applied for. A fee representative of the usual practice in such cases is 5 guineas.
