GEORGE MURDOCH

has surveyed during construction and fitting the Engines and Boilers constructed by Messrs. Palmers Shipbuilding & Iron Co.Ltd. as their Contract No. 886 and fitted on board the Steamer "TYMERIC" built by Messrs. R. & W. Hawthorn Leslie & Co.Ltd. Hebburn-on-Tyne (Yard No.499).

The said Engines and Boilers have been built under Special Survey and in accordance with the Rules of this Society for a working pressure of 180 lbs. and if fitted in a vessel classed or intended to be classed with the Society would be entitled to a record of RLMC. 5.19 in the Register Book.

The three (single ended) boilers were tested under a hydraulic pressure of 360 lbs. per square inch on the 18th October, 25th October and 1st November 1918 respectively. See Test Certificates attached hereto.

After fitting, the machinery was tried under steam and found satisfactory.
