All water ballast tanks to be tested in way of gusset angles

After peak tank top & bulkhead to be tested when stern tube is fitted

Downer pump & hand pumps to be tested.

Watertight doors to be tried.

Achwantship brackets to be fitted to all hold channel pillars

Pumping arrangements to be examined

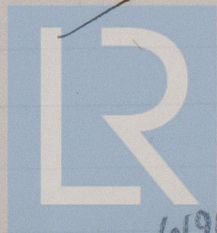
Freeboard to be marked.

Deck plating & casings (in way of machinery space) to be completed as necessary.
