It is submitted the Surveyor be requested to state whether the frames of this vessel are $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}" \times .46$ bulb angles as reported, & as shown on the 'midship section' which he forwarded with his letter of the 4th ultimo, or $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}" \times .50$ as shown on the 'midship section' approved in this office on August 18th 1916.

The 1st Entry report & the abovementioned midship section should be returned to the Surveyor who should be again requested to make the plans & report agree in regard to the scantlings of the frames, beams, etc
