

Sailing vessel 'Countess of Ranfurly'

The Auckland Surveyor reports that this is a sailing vessel, being rigged as a 3 masted schooner. She has been fitted with a screw propeller worked by an oil engine, which is only intended to be used during calms. This can only be considered as an auxiliary means of propulsion.

It is submitted that the vessel should be recorded as a Sailing vessel, & that a note should be made against her name in the Sailing vessel volume of the Register Book ~~under~~ "Fitted with auxiliary screw worked by Oil Engine". "4 cyl 10½" - 14" 85 Brake H.P."
