The Owners' Superintendent was also informed that the donkey boiler ought to be surveyed now as it was two years overdue and also that as much of the machinery survey as could be done in the time should be carried out. Mr. Pitt added that the following parts are being surveyed now, namely :- the tail shaft and the main boiler furnaces, but that no part of the survey of the hull is being held.
