How Done: Vessel placed in Dry Dock Bottom & Rudder cleaned examined and coated

The temporary repairs as per Reg. rpt 15622 were examined & found good. The riveting & caulking of 1 Indented upper OR Shutter plate in way of N°2 hatch & 1 Indented Shell & OR Shutter plate in way of N°3 hatch were examined & found good. The decks, lower decks, Masts, Sticks, Statches, Equipment, Storing Gear, & Ropes were examined as far as possible & found in good condition. Owing to the vessel being generally in good condition, in my opinion the completion of the Special Survey N°2 might be deferred for the present. The vessel is on Govt. Service
