Sir Raylton Dixon & Co's No. 554, and with regard to this case I am directed to inform you that the Principal Outdoor Surveyor on this Establishment has also inspected the hand steering gear and reports his concurrence in your recommendation as regards the support which should be fitted to the spindle of this gear.
