The Cardiff Surveyors now report this vessel has been examined in dry dock, and the bottom cleaned and coated.

The lower part of the rudder post was found to be open and has been repaired by fitting efficient clamp plates.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 8. 16, as recommended.
