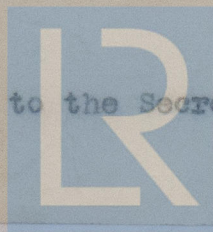
I duly received Mr. Gilmour's letter of the 18th instant respecting the new steamer "DARTMEET" built by Messrs. J. Meyer's Shipbuilding Co. of Zalt Bommel and now having her machinery fitted on board at your port, and in reply thereto I am directed to state that in the circumstances set forth in Mr. Gilmour's letter the proposal to lift the donkey boiler, giving a clearance of 6½" between it and the roof of the recess, will be approved provided sheet iron is fitted to the bottom of the beams in way of the recess and the space between it and the top of the recess is packed with silicate of cotton to your satisfaction. The distance between the chimney and the bulkhead should be as required by Section 30 of the Rules.
