

This vessel is now at Middlesborough and the Local Surveyors of Lloyds Registry have requested additional bulkhead stiffeners to be fitted to the peak bulkhead.

As this request is most unusual after the bulkheads have been tested when they were in Rotterdam, we would ask that the matter be reconsidered, in the hope of avoiding delay in the ultimate completion of the vessel.

It is, we believe, the fact that the stiffeners requested are as per rule and the Amsterdam Surveyor wired his Colleagues at Middlesborough that the stiffening had to be fitted and no sugges-
