Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that it appears from a first entry report which has been received in this Office on the new steamer "DARTMEET" built by Messrs. J. Meijers Shipbuilding Company of Zaft-Bommel that this vessel is proceeding to Middlesbrough where the machinery will be fitted.

In the circumstances I think it well to inform you that in order to complete the vessel's classification the anchors and chain cable and ship's inventory require to be supplied, windlass bedplate to be renewed, steam steering engine and gear and steam winches to be fitted. Top of engine and boiler casing requires to be closed up and riveted, aftermost top plate of tunnel to be riveted, handpumps to be tested, compasses to be fitted and adjusted and net tonnages to be fixed and recorded.

I shall therefore be glad to receive your report on form 8 in due course with a view to the steamer's classification being completed and rendering her eligible to be classed in the Society's Register Book.
