In reply to London letter of the 16th inst, I beg to state the tests of the $1\frac{1}{16}$ stream chain are $30\frac{4}{10}$ tons, breaking, and $20\frac{3}{10}$ statutory as required.

Regarding the hawseers and warps supplied to this vessel, they were specified by Owners and approved on midship section,

2 @ 90 fthms 2" steel wire,	} and these were supplied to the vessel.
2 @ 90 " 5" manilla hawser.	
2 @ 90 " 4" warp.	

The Rule required

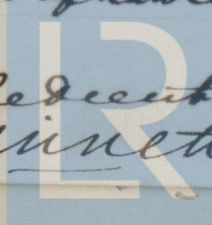
2 @ 90 fthms 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ steel wire.
2 @ 90 " 5 manilla hawser.

I am now informed that just before leaving Troon another 90 fthms of $3\frac{1}{2}$ " steel wire hawser and reel were placed on board, so that it will be seen the equipment of hawseers and warps are ample.
