I have to inform you that reports have been received from the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp ~~concerning~~ steel screw Barges Nos. 355 & 356 built by Messrs. Van Damme Freres & Adam, from which it would appear that these vessels had left that port for Hull, where their machinery is to be fitted on board, and anchors, chains and hawsers supplied, and the after-peak tanks are to be tested. I have therefore to request that you will give these cases the necessary attention, and on completion of the work forward a report on form 8 in the usual manner, with a view to the classification of the vessels.


