With reference to the first entry reports forwarded to-day on the steel screw barges Nos 355 - 356 built by Messrs Van Damme Freres & Adam, I beg to inform you that these vessels which have not yet been named or measured for tonnage have left for Hull to have the Machinery and boilers placed on board, and the anchors, chains, and hawsers have also to be supplied, and the after peak tank remains to be tested when the stern tube is fitted.


The Surveyors at Hull have been duly advised.

In regard to our last date of survey on these cases it was understood from the Builders that the equipment would be supplied by them and they were to advise us when this would be carried out, and they have only now informed us that this matter would be attended to at Hull, the barges leaving here on the 22nd instant.
