With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "BELLBANK", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a report of a survey held on this vessel at Algiers, and that in view of the condition of the hull and machinery as now reported, the Committee must ask you to make arrangements for the steamer to be generally examined by the Society's Surveyors at a very early date. I shall be pleased to learn what definite arrangements you propose making in the matter.

It is noted that you recently informed the Society's Surveyors at Hull that it was your intention to carry out the necessary repairs to the vessel, and hold the Special Survey No.3 probably within three weeks from then.
