Dear Sirs,

With reference to the survey which has recently been held here on the machinery of your steamer "CLAN MATHESON", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting today the Surveyor's report from which it appears that to entitle the vessel to a record of #LMC 7,14 the following remains to be done, viz:-

4 longitudinal steam space stays in donkey boiler to be renewed; the main steam pipes to be annealed & tested and the condenser and all cocks & valves to be examined.

It is understood to be your intention to complete the survey on the machinery and carry out the same on the hull on the vessel's return from her present voyage and I have the pleasure to say that this arrangement has been agreed to by the Committee.
