*The vessel has been examined in dry dock on account of having grounded at the time of launching, and no damage found to have been sustained. see Newcastle report No. 54344 attached.*

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed  $\pm 100A1$  ("Steel") *Shelter deck* with freeboard," as recommended. The Summer freeboard of 3'-5" from centre of disc to top of statutory deck line at upper deck, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate, and recorded in the Register Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying verification form to be inserted in the certificate of classification.


