Gentlemen,

I duly received Mr. Tierney's letter of the 29th instant, forwarding one from the Clyde Shipbuilding & Engineering Co. respecting the equipment proposed for the Canadian Lake Steamer No. 289 now building by them, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the equipment shown on the sketch of midship section (omitting the third bower anchor) was approved by the Committee on the 22nd October last, provided the consent of the Owners be obtained to the omission of the third bower anchor, as per my letter of that date addressed to the Builders, of which a copy was sent to you.

As the Builders have now forwarded a copy of a letter from the Owners agreeing to the omission of the third bower anchor, I have to acquaint you that the matter is in order.
