Nature of Survey *COMPLETION OF st S.S. No. 3*The *1st* S.S. No. *3* partly held at *Rotterdam*now completed, and the following repairs done (due to *wear & tear*):-

*Vessel placed in drydock, bottom coated,
 3 shell plates renewed & some plating fairied
 A number of frames in fore hold strengthened by
 fitting reverse frames, ^{strengthening struts in hold renewed} repairs to bunkers, casings,
 ceiling & minor repairs*

*It was not considered necessary to drill the
 shell plating.*

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record
 of Survey *H. 28* and notation of *S.S. st 3-4-28* as recommended.
