REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage stated due to Collision with "ARIADNE ALEXANDRA" in South Basin Cardiff 11 Nov 1916

Vessel examined afloat: On port side amidships, 1 main sheer strake plate, and 1 plate in strake below, found slightly indented; frames, beams, deck & unaffected. Riving & caulking in vicinity of indent now examined. Vessel's efficiency being in no way affected, and immediate sailing urgently required, Owners' proposal to defer fairing the plating, merits approval.
