Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to a bower anchor of proper weight & test being supplied to replace one on board, and the stream chain being tested; to a Special Survey, equal to a Half Time Survey, being held at 4 & 8 years, and to the main deck being permanently repaired.

The Rotterdam Surveyors now report the vessel has been examined in dry dock- bottom recoated.

The main deck has been repaired to the Surveyors' satisfaction.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with fresh record of survey 10.19, subject as above, except as regards the main deck.
