Memo D.W. Henderson's No 452 is a sister vessel to the Ss. Ashburton (No 445), and the Owners wish to dispense with cement in the double bottom, as approved for that vessel, see London letter of 30th June 1905. In the case of the Ss. Ashburton the outside strakes and keel plate were cemented up flush with the inside strakes. I enclose copy of midship section for reference, also the Builder's letter.
