Repairs are required to tank top under boilers.

The 3rd S.S. No. 1 became due 9.40, and a General Examination partly held at Greenock in November last requires to be completed.


The MIDDLESBROUGH Surveyors now report that in lieu of completing the General Examination it was decided to commence the Special Survey, and the greater part has, in fact, been held, the vessel being in dry dock and the bottom coated.

Repairs and renewals have been effected to tank top under boilers, as above, tank tops, bulkheads, decks, casings, etc.

It is submitted action be deferred.
