I have to acquaint you that it appears from correspondence which has passed between this Office and the Society's Surveyors at Malta, that the steamer "ARCHBANK" damaged by collision, had temporary repairs effected at Gibraltar, to enable her to proceed on another voyage. No report appears to have been received from you of survey held on the temporary repairs, and I shall be glad to know whether this vessel came under your inspection, as I may remind you that in accordance with the Society's Rules, all repairs effected to classed vessels at a port where the Society has Surveyors stationed, are required to be carried out under the inspection and to the satisfaction of the Surveyors.
