Nature of Survey DAMAGE.

The Halifax Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat on account of damage through encountering heavy weather. X
A shell plate on Port side of No. 1 hold found leaking in forward frame space at 2nd stringer from bottom.
The Starboard lifeboat found missing has been replaced by a new boat and minor repairs effected.

Temporary repairs have been effected to their satisfaction, ^{to the shell plate}
and the Surveyors recommend permanent repairs to damaged plating on port side of No. 1 Hold in way of forward frame space and 2nd stringer from bottom on vessel's return to the U.K.

It is submitted, ~~the vessel is eligible to remain as classed without record of survey subject as recommended.~~
