M. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant in further reference to the alterations to be carried out to the T.S.S. "ZAMZAM", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the stiffening arranged by you to be fitted to convert No.5 hold into a fresh water tank is considered satisfactory.

It is noted that this stiffening will be fitted after the present pilgrim season, and that in the meantime you have granted a certificate for this compartment to be used for the carriage of fresh water up to the top of the tunnels only.
