Dear Sir,

With reference to the S/S "ZAMZAM" now under survey at the completion of 2nd Special Survey N°3 and at the same time the Owners propose to make structural alterations to the vessel's upper decks to increase the carrying of the number of passengers. I have, therefore, dispatched by post to day the plans of the proposed arrangements in duplicate, received to-day.

The Owners are desirous of the Society's Classification approval of the arrangements proposed, before commencing the work and I should feel obliged for the Committee's early attention in this matter as the Owners wish to advance the work as soon as possible.

I have to add that further plans are being awaited for proposed alterations in regard to using part of the N°5 lower hold as a pump tank for carrying fresh water, also the after end of the N°4 lower hold <sup>as a</sup> deep tank for carrying fuel oil.

The plan of the arrangements proposed will be posted soon as received.

The Owners are agreeable to pay such fees chargeable in connection with the case.
