During the year 1918, there was built in this District a set of triple expansion reciprocating engines for the Steamer, "LA BREA" owned by the Union Oil Company of California.

This machinery was installed on the vessel, the last date of survey being November 9th, 1918, (see Phl. Report No. 3023).

When this work was completed, no interim certificate was asked for or furnished, but I am now informed by our Surveyors at San Francisco, that the Owners require to be provided with a certificate covering the examination of the tail shaft, and I have therefore issued the required document and signed the same on behalf of Mr. Runham, who surveyed the whole of the work. Copy of this certificate is enclosed herewith for your records.
