This vessel was built in 1916 and fitted with a Geared Steam Turbine.

In October 1918 the Philadelphia Surveyors stated that upon examination they found the pinion and gear wheels badly worn and recommended that a new set of High Speed reduction gears be fitted.

A report has now been received from the Philadelphia Surveyors in which it is stated that the Turbine has been replaced by Reciprocating Engines, and the working pressure has been reduced to 190 pounds per square inch to suit the original screw shaft.
