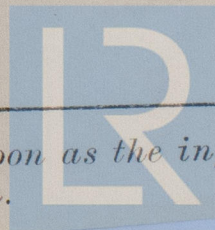
The Owners have been informed by the Mersey Docks & Harbour Board that the salvaging of this vessel must remain in abeyance until the termination of hostilities.
