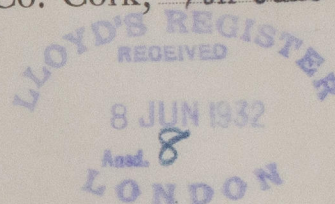

I beg to advise that the outstanding items of Convention Load Line Survey required to this Vessel have now been placed in hand by the Owners, City of Cork Steam Packet Co., Ltd.

These items are recorded in your Freeboard form, marked M. 3rd May last to the Owners, but the work now being carried out is in accordance with the Society's Liverpool Secretary's letter dated 19th May to the Owners: both letters being produced for my information.

Mr Keiths letter modifies the first item of:- "Air pipes which are led above freeboard deck and return down through the deck, having storm valves or other efficient means of closing fitted at the snell," to :- "drilling holes in all air pipes to prevent syphon action."

I am taking it that this modification is in order and the drilling of these pipes is now in hand.
