Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 21st and to the assignment letter addressed to you on the 22nd ultimo relative to the steamer "JACOBUS", I beg to inform you that all the conditions of assignment have been complied with at Barry and Fowey with the exception of the following:-

1. The cross bunker and coal shoot hatchways on the casing top to have battening arrangements and coamings reasonably in accordance with the Convention requirements;
2. The coal hatchways in the bridge space being reasonably in accordance with the Convention requirements.

In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know when and at what port it will best suit your convenience to have these items submitted to the inspection of the Society's Surveyors and the freeboard marks cut in the ship's sides and verified.

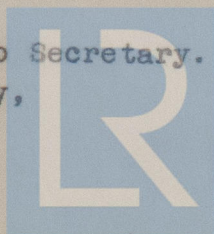
