I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th instant, and the particulars furnished have been inserted in your freeboard report on the steamer "JACOBUS". I shall be glad if you will now forward for the completion of the report full particulars of the companionway to the crew space on the poop deck, of the machinery casings in the bridge space and the exposed machinery casings on the bridge deck, and whether the doors closing the openings in these casings can be efficiently manipulated.

Full particulars should also be given of the coal hatchways in the bridge space and of the coal shoot and cross bunker hatchways on the casing top.
