Dear Sirs,

I enclose herewith the usual letters of assignment for the S.S. "JACOBUS", together with the approved plans, three in number, which were forwarded for reference.

With regard to this case, I have to request that you will describe clearly how the "bolted plates" at the bridge front are secured. The term "bolted plates" is not sufficient to show under which class of closing appliances the arrangement falls.

For the minimum freeboard assigned, the closing appliances at the bridge front must at least comply with Class A requirements.

It is concluded that the hatch webs are fitted at 22 ins. depth at the centre, as shown on the approved plan, and that the depth given as 11 ins. on the report is the depth at the side of the hatchways.
