In reply to your letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the request which has been made by the Owner of the new motorship "BRALANTA" for the periodical surveys to be reckoned from the date when the vessel is again placed in commission, I have to say that in the circumstances of this case, seeing that the vessel is now laid up, the Committee will be agreeable to meeting the Owners' wishes in the matter, but it must be understood that this approval is subject to the vessel being examined in drydock before she proceeds to sea, as provided for in the first paragraph on Page 11 of the Society's Rules.
