With reference to the M.V. "BRALANTA" (The Caledon S.B. & E. Co's Yard No. 336) which is proceeding to your port for installation of the engines, I have to acquaint you that the Surveyors at Dundee report, as follows:-

"The donkey boilers have been satisfactorily fitted on  
"board the vessel, the safety valves adjusted under steam and  
"tried for accumulation; the boilers examined under working  
"conditions and found satisfactory. The cargo heating pipes  
"in all cargo tanks, fwd. deep tank, side bunker tanks and aft  
"peak tested by hydraulic pressure. The bunker oil transfer  
"pipes on deck and pump room tested by hydraulic pressure.  
"The sea connections examined and found satisfactory. The  
"machinery is eligible to have the record of \* LMC when the  
"survey is complete".
