The Board of Admiralty regrets to announce that H.M. trawler *Kingston Sapphire* (Lieutenant L. A. Sayers, R.N.R.) has been lost by U-boat action. The majority of the crew have been landed. The next of kin have been informed.

Of 356 tons gross, and built at *Beverley* in 1929, the *Kingston Sapphire* was formerly owned by the *Kingston Steam Trawling Company, Ltd.* of *Hull*.
