Dear Mr. Ward,


Reverting to my letter of the 5th instant regarding the S.S. "ST. TROPEZ" ex "WAR HALTON", I have received this morning from the Board of Trade the British Corporation freeboard computation, and I enclose a copy of the measurements reported, which please pass on to the Surveyors at Marseilles to check and make out their own report. I prefer them to use the form 11b with the English measurements, as it saves a lot of labour, and at the end of the computation we turn the figures into millimetres for assignment.
