Dear Mr. Ward,

I am this morning in receipt of your telegram as follows, namely,

"St. Tropez ex War Halton classed B.C. now under survey

"vessel must have freeboard assigned by Lloyds or  
"Veritas consider certificate now on board not even  
"sufficient if modified to suit French requirements  
"and that vessel must be remeasured please confirm",

and have to confirm mine in reply as follows, namely,

"St. Tropez please arrange Marseilles Surveyor furnish  
"freeboard report eleven b form for our assignment stop  
"have asked Board Trade oblige with original report  
"stop will send copy for guidance as soon as received".

On making enquiry of the Board of Trade, I learn that they have not received the British Corporation freeboard report, but they promise to write for it and send it on to me as soon as received.
