The work of demolishing the above vessel commenced at North Queensferry in July, 1947.

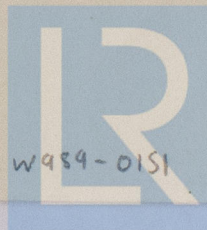
