

the Builders of the vessel and of the Owners, survey the ss. "WESTBURY" of London, with view to ascertaining the nature and extent of damage stated to have been sustained on 11th January 1928, through striking the dock wall while being moved in the Harbour of Burntisland from her finishing off berth to her coaling berth.

On 12th January 1928 while lying afloat in the Harbour of Burntisland surveyed the vessel and found the shell plating slightly set in on Port side forward and indented in two places on Starboard side.

Representatives of the Builders and of the Owner's of the vessel stated it was not convenient to carry out repairs at the Port of Burntisland or at Leith at this time but that the vessel will be dry docked and presented for further survey upon her arrival at Cardiff or Barry.

The damages sustained do not affect the seaworthiness of the vessel and no recommendations for repairs in connection with the damages in question were made.
